January 2020: This one-story house is located on the north side of Rosser Avenue East. The site slopes downhill towards the north. There are box hedges around the front and southeast property lines. There is a driveway on the west end of the property. This property consists of a house.

Surveyor Assessment:

January 2020: According to the City of Charlottesville Property Records, this house was constructed in 1925 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). It first appears on the 1929 Sanborn Map as 709 Rose Avenue or Preston Avenue NW as one of a series of similarly footprinted houses (Sanborn Map Company 1929). The rear open porch visible in the 1929 and 1950 Sanborn Maps was enclosed at an unknown date (Sanborn Map Company 1950; USGS 1994; USGS 2007; USGS 2017).

This property retains excellent integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship for this property have been mildly compromised by replacement cladding, the enclosure of the rear porch, and replacement windows. This property retains excellent integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource.

January 2020: This one-story house is clad vinyl siding and has a front-gabled roof covered in asphalt shingles. There is an interior brick chimney nearly on the ridgeline in the center of the building. The front (south) facing façade features a one-story, almost full-width, open porch with a shed roof. The porch roof is supported by square wood posts. The porch has wood railings, and is accessed via concrete steps. The main entrance is in the center of this facade. All visible windows have fixed wood shutters. The rear (north) elevation has a full-width, shed roof wing also clad in vinyl siding. Visible fenestration includes one-over-one, double-hung, vinyl windows; and a single-leaf, wood door with a metal and glass storm door.
