**Site Description:** 

January 2020: This two-story house is located on the south side of West Street. There is a wood fence that surrounds the whole property, and large trees throughout the rear of the lot. This property includes a house and a shed.

#### **Surveyor Assessment:**

January 2020: According to Charlottesville City Property Records, this house was built in 1925 (City of Charlottesville GIS Viewer 2020). However, a building with the same footprint is visible in the 1920 Sanborn Map (Sanborn Map Company 1920). The only difference between the 1920 and 1929 Sanborn Maps is the enclosure of a one-story porch on the southeast corner of the house (Sanborn Map Company 1929; Sanborn Map Company 1929). There is a garage in the southeast corner of the property in both the 1929 and 1950 Sanborn Maps (Sanborn Map Company 1929; Sanborn Map Company 1950). While this garage is in the same place as the current shed, they have different footprints, and the current shed does not appear on aerials until around 2006, though it could have been constructed earlier since the aerials are obstructed by tree cover (USGS 2006).

This property retains excellent integrity of location and setting. The integrity of design, materials, and workmanship have been mildly compromised by replacement cladding. The property retains excellent integrity of feeling and association. Overall, this property retains good integrity.

This property is recommended as not individually eligible for listing in the NRHP due to a lack of historical significance. However, it is located in the potential 10th & Page Historic District, which is recommended as potentially eligible for listing in the NRHP. Further study is recommended to determine if the 10th & Page Historic District is eligible for listing in the NRHP under Criterion A in the areas of Ethnic Heritage, Community Planning and Development, and Social History, and under Criterion C in the area of Architecture. This property includes one contributing primary resource and one non-contributing secondary resource.

January 2020: This two-story house sits on a concrete foundation, is clad in vinyl siding, and has a hipped-on-hipped roof with a shed roof in the south corner covered in standing seam metal. The front-facing (northeast) facade includes a one-story, full-width, open porch with a hipped roof covered in asphalt shingles. The porch roof is supported by square wood columns and the porch has wood railings. The main entrance to this house is located at the east end of the facade. Visible fenestration includes six-over-six, double-hung, vinyl windows, some with metal screens; and a single-leaf, wood door with a metal and glass storm door.
