Much-altered industrial building with unusual double-gable roof with what appears to be an enclosed clerestory nestled between them. Original features include sections of corrugated metal siding, roof ventilators, and electrical attachments and booms on the roof ridge.

The building is mostly faced with false half-timbered and stuccoed panels with a skirt of brick along the front sidewalk. The principal entry is located on the north side; another entry in an arched embrasure is located on the street.

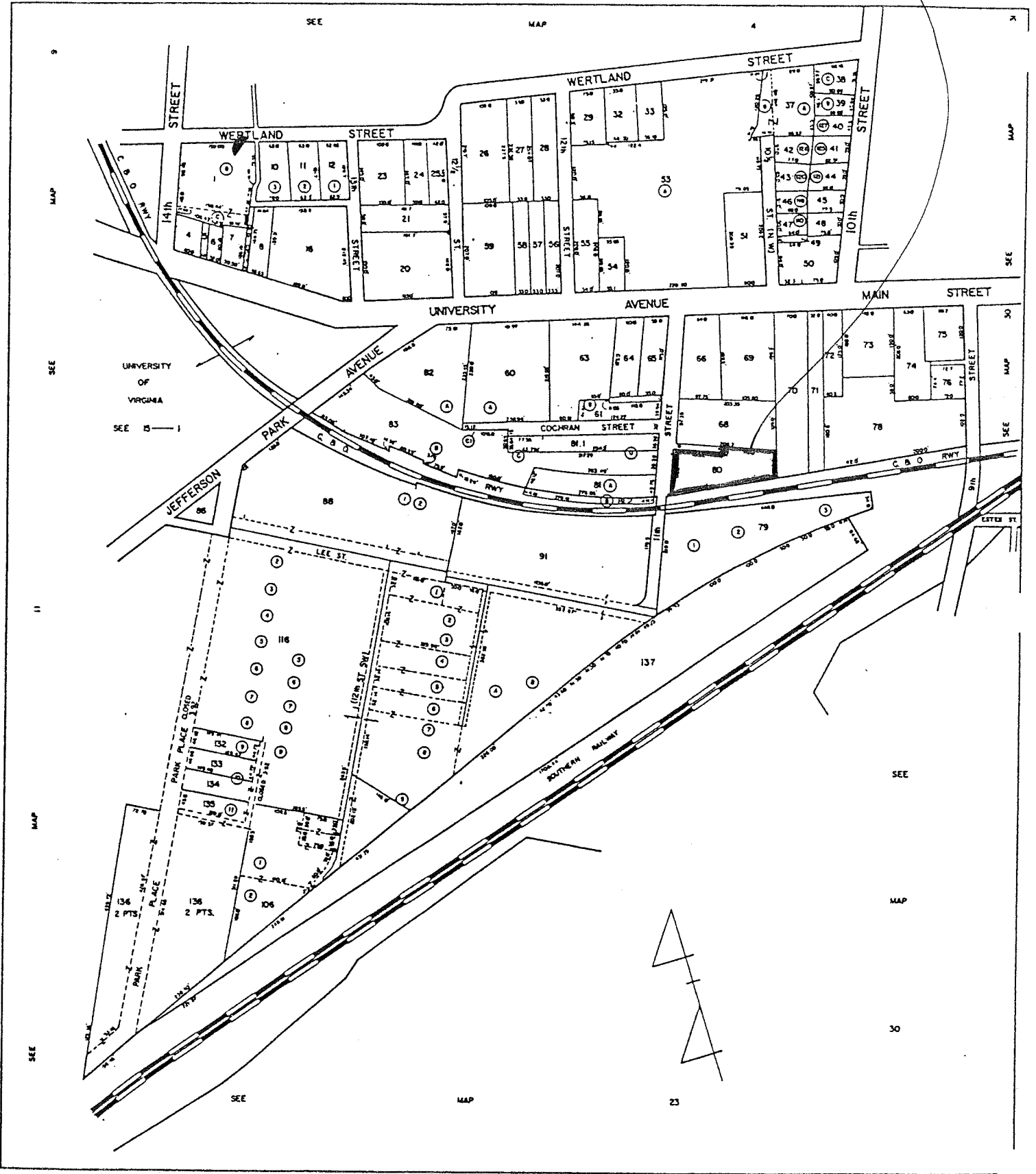

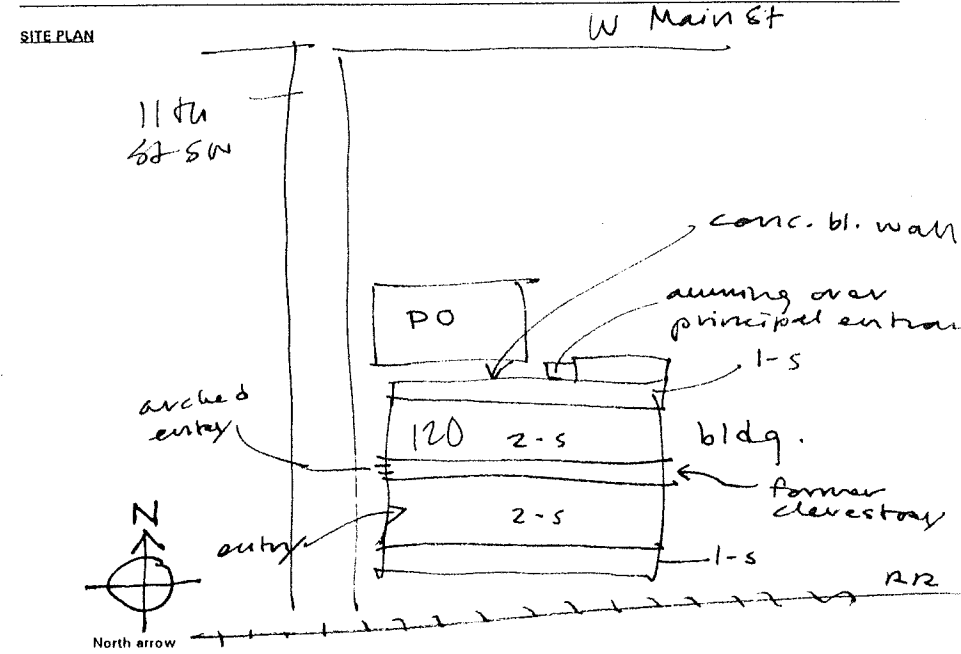
