217: brick(stretcher bond); 2½ story; hip roof with intersecting front gable, slate; 1 dormer on south side; 3 bays; 1 story, 2 bay L-shaped porch with Tuscan columns, dentil cornice and plain balustrade; Queen Anne; ca. 1900; Frontal gable has staggered butt shingles; full entablature at eave; south 2 bays recessed in succession; northern bay is a 3-sided projection; entrances in southern and central bays; central entry has double door with transom; 1/1 double hung sash windows; 3/1 window in gable end; 2 internal chimneys.
