



Stucco faces N → Lawn, I JPA, looked over Valley Rd → Dashed  
Build in 2 stages? stucco doesn't show

Brick (6-8 in) found, low, <sup>stone</sup> retaining wall for basement  
above ground at rear

Stucco of chocolate brown tan

1-fl open stair w/ simple bal in ~~the~~ east or side hall

2 int ~~ext~~ caged brick chimneys; 2-3 fireplaces



2-storey, rear, East, "orig" section

2-storey, 2-bay, double-pile

wooden stringcourse below 2nd storey windowmills,  
vertical timbers <sup>smooth & white stucco</sup> above

high-pitched hips roof, ab shingle, exposed rafter ends,  
<sup>deeply</sup> <sup>gray</sup> eaves

windows 7/7, plain trim, cornice, same lit both levels
