ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

The Howard Johnson's Motel Building is eight stories tall and six bays wide. The bays are separated by slender metal piers. Each bay has two pairs of sliding glass patio doors, one at each end of the bay. Doors on the rear elevation have balconies; those on the facade, metal balustrades without the balconies. The walls of the building are veneered with brick. The effect is of alternating vertical bands of brick and glass. doors. There are concrete corner posts and a concrete parapet. The ends of the building are blank except for one single-paned window on each level, with Howard Johnson's trademark turquoise panels between them, and concrete piers framing this vertical strip. A 2-story concrete parking garage, with a swimming pool above it at the third story level, extends to the rear of the building with the parking deck extending into the main block at the second story level and projects on the facade. A heavy band of concrete panels screens this level on the facade and side elevations and provides a backdrop for the motel and restaurant signs and logos. At the first story level, a porte cochere is set into the building, occupying the eastern bay. The exit from the parking garage is in the second bay from the western end of the building facade Thus, much of the building is open at the first story level. Some of the supporting piers and walls are faced with fieldstone. The restaurant occupies the other three bays of the facade and projects from them. It has fieldstone and plate glass walls and a gabled roof. The roof is now painted bright blue. A small Howard Johnson's gable is applied to the concrete panel above the porte cochere.

HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION

Nathan and Corinne Poole purchased two adjacent lots at the northwestern corner of West Main Street and Thirteenth Street in 1963 (City DB 246-403 & 407) and two years later deeded them and a lot behind them on Wertland Street to Logan Manders as trustee (DB 265-271-109). A very old 3-story brick house at 1301 West Main Street had been replaced with a service station in the 1930's. The adjoining lot apparently was vacant until c. 1950 when a building to house an automobile dealership was erected. These automotive buildings were demolished, and the present building was erected for Howard Johnson's Motel in 1966-67.


