ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

This very plain, but functional, structure is typical of service stations built in the 1920's and 1930's. The one-storey building is two bays wide with a shelter for gas pumps projecting from the western bay and supported by two large square piers. Wall construction is of brick faced with stucco. The L-shaped, medium-pitched hip roof is covered with red tile and has deeply projecting eaves with a boxed cornice. There is an interior chimney. There is a garage door in the eastern bay of the facade. In the western bay, a display window is flanked by entrance doors, all with narrow surrounds and multi-light rectangular transoms. A similar door and two small windows are on the western elevation, while the eastern elevation is blank.

HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION

F. W. Twyman purchased this lot in 1929 (City DB 67-68) and replaced the house that was there with a service station in 1921. The Whiting Oil Co., inc., bought it from his estate in 1946 (DB 129-354) and sold it to Morris P. Puckett in 1976 (DB 376-593).
