ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

The J. Enmett Gleason House combines Victorian massing with Colonial Revival detail, as do many houses built in the early years of the twentieth century. It is two storeys tall, two bays wide, and double pile, with a projecting pavilion at the rear of the north side of the house. The lot slopes steeply away from the street, and the house is set on a very high concrete foundation so that the basement is above ground on three sides, but the front yard has been filled in to the level of the water table. Wall construction is of brick laid in 7-course American bond. The house has a medium-pitched, L-shaped hip roof covered with slate. There are gables centered over the facade and the projecting pavilion. The roof has projecting eaves and verges, a boxed comice with returns, and a plain frieze. There are two small interior end chimneys. The tall windows are segmental-arched, double-sash, 1-over-1 light, with wooden sills and moulded surrounds. Those at the second level are shorter, and the first storey window on the facade is wider. Basement windows are also segmental-arched, and some are half-sized hinged sash. A one-storey veranda covers the facade and extends along the north side as far as the projecting pavilion. It has a low-pitched hip roof covered with standing-seam metal with projecting eaves, boxed cornice, plain frieze, Tuscan columns, and a simple balustrade. A semi-eliptical-arched entrance is located in the north bay of the main block. The door has a single large pane of glass, and there are single-light sidelights and semi-eliptical transom. A 2-flight open stair with simple balustrade rises from the rear of the entrance hall in the center front of the house. The wall between the entrance hall and parlor extends only half way to the ceiling between square pillars. The brick fireplace in the parlor has a plain wooden mantel shelf. There is a built-in oak china press on the dining room. Access to the sun parlor from the dining room is by a pair of 10-light French doors. A nearly oofed 2-storey complex of enclosed porches covers the rar of the main block. Two segmental-arched doors give access to an open porch at the basement level. The southern portion of the first storey level is a sun parlor enclosed with weatherboarding and 6-over-6 and 8-over-8 light windows. The rest of the first level of the back porch is open and has wooden piers and a solid wooden balustrade. The second storey is a sleeping porch enclosed with vertical siding and 8-over-8 light windows.

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HISTORICAL DESCRIPTION

J. Emmett Gleason purchased this lot in 1915 (City DB 29-480) and built the house immediately, according to family and tax records. Mr. Gleason had been raised at 522 Ridge Street and was a partner with his father and brother in the firm of H. M. Gleason and Co. After living in this house for over a quarter century, the Gleasons sold it to Ross C. & Freda K. Garletts in 1943 (DB 115-206) and moved to the Abell-Gleason House on North First Street. In 1958 the Charlottesville & Albemarie Community Chest, Inc., bought the house for the Janie Porter Barrett Day Care Center (DB 205-116). Now the oldest day care center in the state, it was founded in 1935 and had occupied the Bethel Institutional Baptist Church building at 501 Commerce Street since the mid-1940's. Except for alterations made in 1958 to comply with the fire code - notably the addition of two fire escapes - the Gleason House remains essentially unchanged. The adjacent lot has always been vacant and has been owned by the owner of this house most of the time since 1936.

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
