Well-executed mid-twentieth-century Classical Revival commercial building, with Jeffersonian elements. One-story with hipped roof, three-bay front facade dominated by half-octagon loggia-type porch, recessed into front wall, with three bays with round-arched openings containing keystones, springing from molded brick course. Has two large interior chimneys with Chippendale balustrade between; Chippendale railing at fixed 35-light windows. Has rear section with flat roof.

Little-altered - window modifications on southeast wall, where full-length windows replaced by smaller, fixed 16-light units.

Significance Statement:

This is a high-quality, well-designed example of Jeffersonian Classical Revival, which blends well into its setting. Although not yet fifty years of age, the building is an important component of the streetscape leading from the commercial Corner to the University.

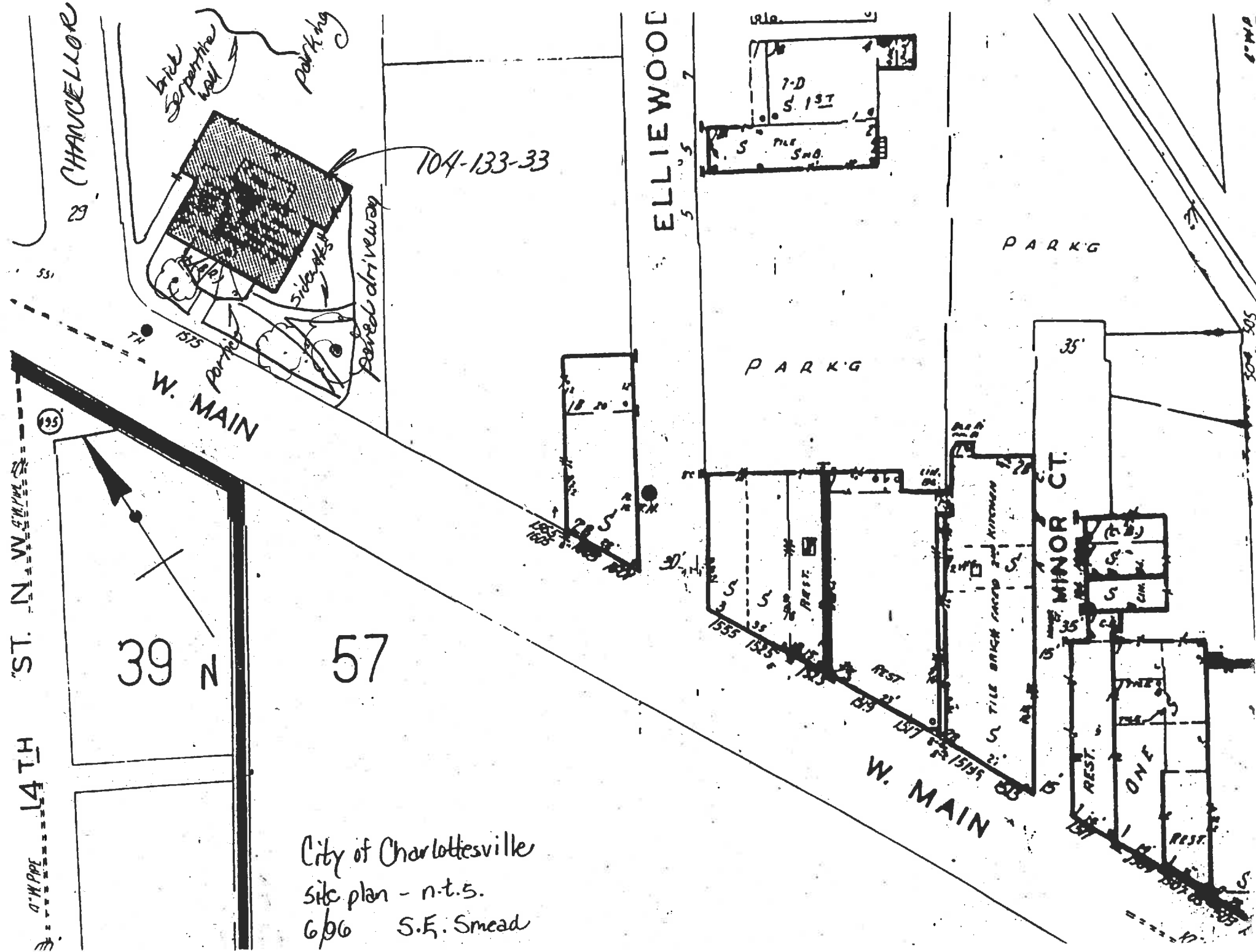

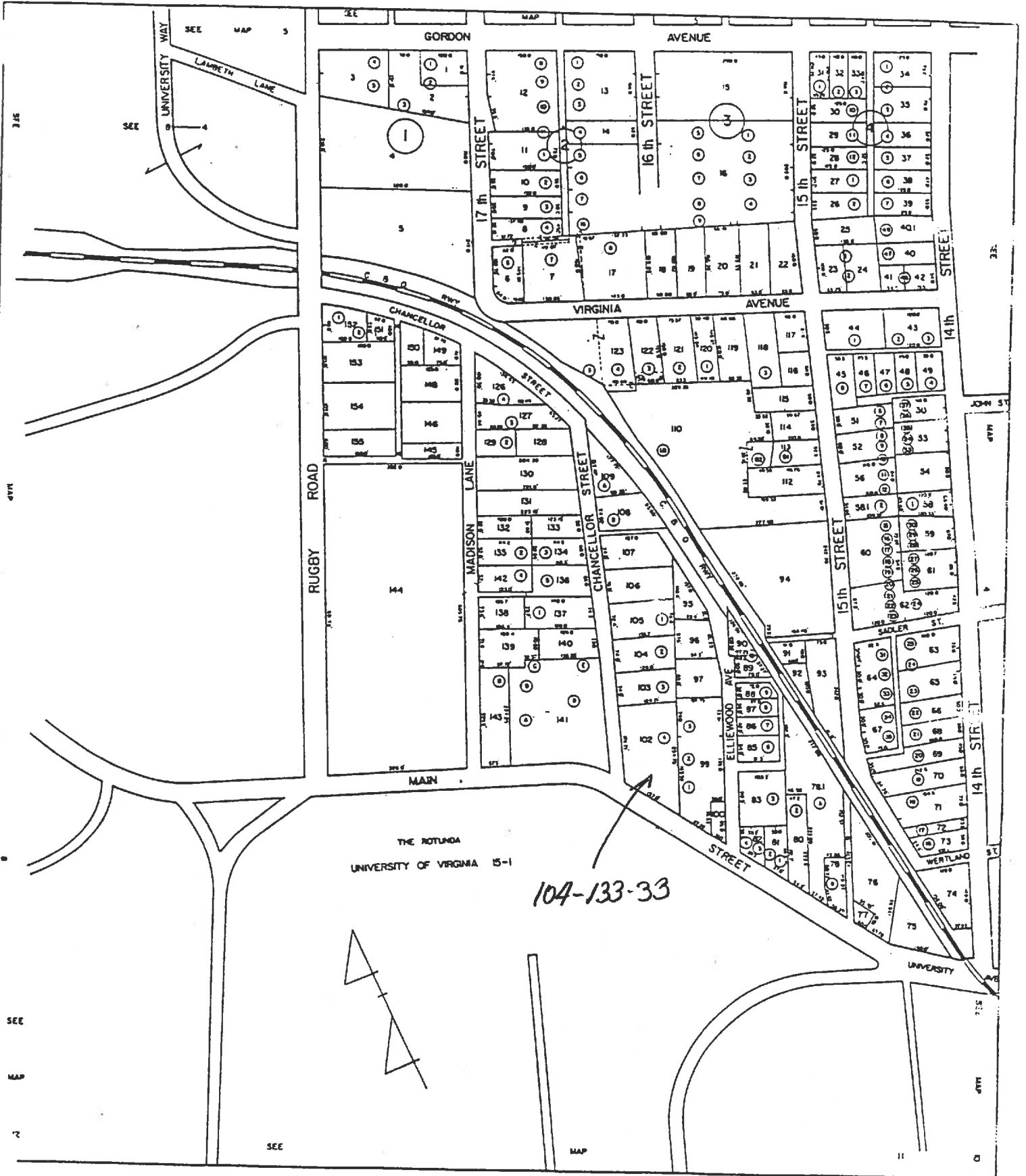

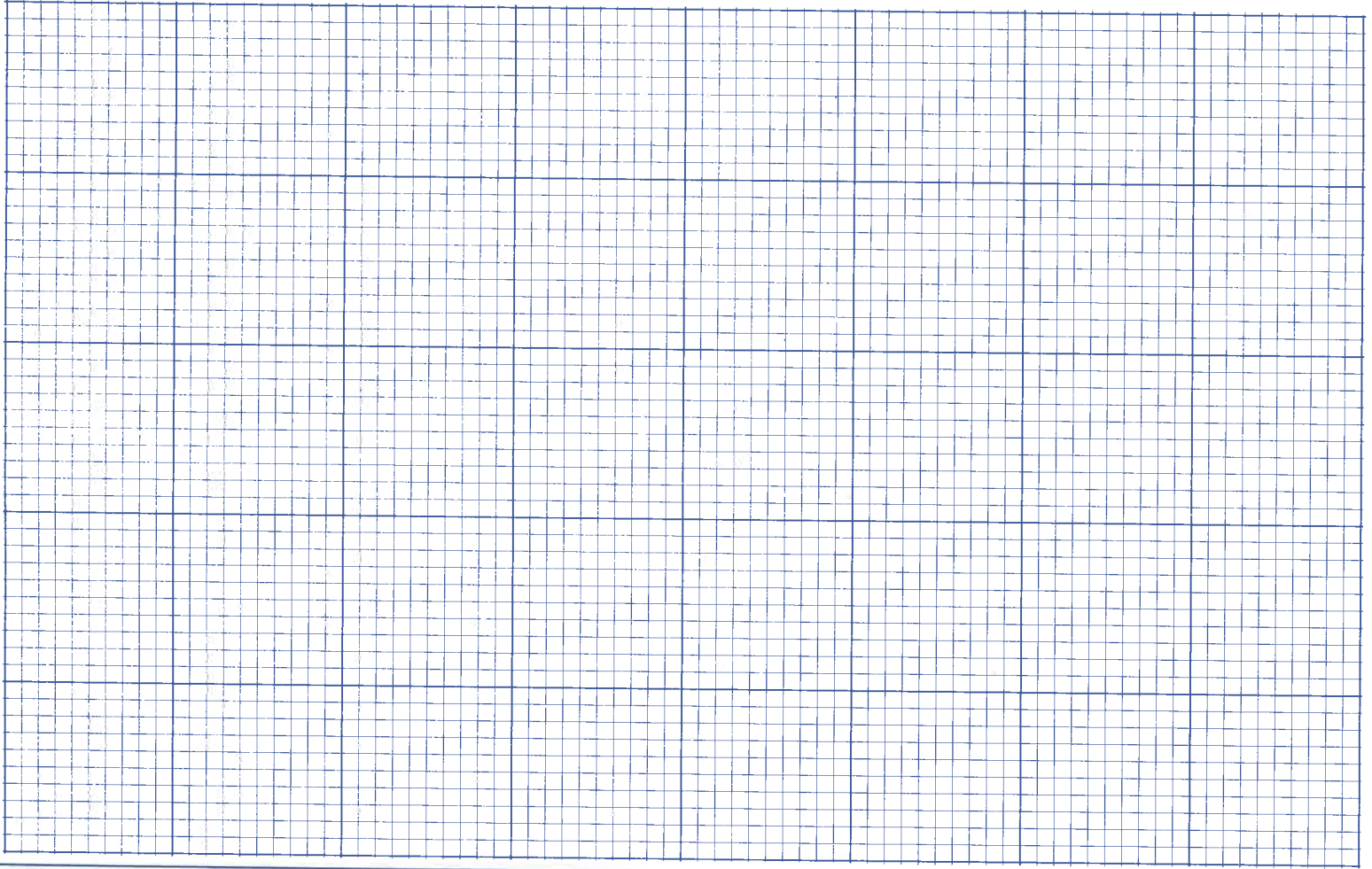
