RESOLUTION GRANTING AN INFILL SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR A NEW SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL LOT AT 715 NALLE STREET

WHEREAS, Stephen Hitchcock and Kendall Cox, contract-purchasers of the property at 715 Nalle Street, have requested an infill special use permit with respect to the property identified on City Tax Map 30 as Parcel 37, consisting of approximately 0.25 acre or 10,800 square feet ("Subject Property"), for a new single family residential lot; and

WHEREAS, Stephen Hitchcock and Kendall Cox have requested an infill special use permit at 715 Nalle Street to allow a density of 7.87 dwelling units per acre, and changes in the following requirements for R-1S development:

- a. Reduce the required lot frontage from fifty feet (50') to thirty-six feet (36');
- b. Reduce the lot size requirement from 6,000 square feet to 5,532 square feet; and
- c. Allow the new pervious driveway to be located less than three feet (3') from the adjoining property.

WHEREAS, the Subject Property is zoned "R-1S" (Residential District-Small Lot Single Family) and, pursuant to §34-165 of the City Code, such modifications for use of the property are allowed by Special Use Permit; and

WHEREAS, following a joint public hearing before this Council and the Planning Commission, duly advertised and held on August 14, 2012, this Council finds that such use is allowed under City Code Section 34-165 by special use permit, and will conform to the criteria applicable to special permits generally under Chapter 34 of the City Code; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Charlottesville, Virginia that a special use permit is hereby approved and granted to Stephen Hitchcock and Kendall Cox for a new single family residential lot at 715 Nalle Street. Approval of this special use permit is conditioned upon the following:

- 1. Staff approval of the LID features presented on an engineering plan.
- 2. A dwelling built on the newly created lot shall be entitled only to one residential parking permit.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF A PORTION OF THE OLD LYNCHBURG ROAD RIGHT OF WAY TO FRY'S SPRING BEACH CLUB, INC.

WHEREAS, Fry's Spring Beach Club, Inc. (FSBC), the owner of property designated as Parcel 34 on City Real Estate Tax Map 19 (2512 Jefferson Park Avenue), wishes to acquire a portion of the adjoining Old Lynchburg Road right of way, as shown on the attached plat by AECOM dated July 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with <u>Virginia Code</u> Sec. 15.2-1800(B), a public hearing was held to give the public an opportunity to comment on the proposed conveyance of the City property as requested by FSBC; and

WHEREAS, the City Assessor, Department of Neighborhood Services, and Department of Public Works have reviewed the proposed conveyance and have no objection thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Charlottesville, Virginia that the Mayor is authorized to execute a deed of quitclaim, in form approved by the City Attorney, for that portion of the Old Lynchburg Road right of way, approximately 2,488 square feet in area (0.057 acres), adjacent to Parcel 34 on City Tax Map 19, and shown on the attached plat by AECOM dated July 31, 2012. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to effect the closing of said property conveyance.





AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A REQUEST TO REZONE PROPERTY LOCATED AT PENN PARK LANE (TAX MAP PARCELS 48A-39 AND 48A-40) FROM R-2 (RESIDENTIAL – TWO FAMILY) TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (LOCHLYN HILL)

WHEREAS, Milestone Partners, LLC ("Applicant"), agent for the Owner of property off Penn Park Lane designated as Parcels 39 and 40 on City Tax Map 48A, submitted an application seeking a rezoning of such property from R-2 (Residential-Two Family) to Planned Unit Development (PUD), hereinafter the "Proposed Rezoning"; and

WHEREAS, a joint public hearing on the Proposed Rezoning was held before the City Council and Planning Commission on July 10, 2012, following notice to the public and to adjacent property owners as required by law; and

WHEREAS, legal notice of the public hearing held on July 10, 2012 was advertised in accordance with Va. Code Sec. 15.2-2204; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant submitted a Preliminary Proffer Statement dated June 11, 2012, as required by City Code Section 34-64(a), and presented the Preliminary Proffer Statement to the Planning Commission on July 10, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2012, the Planning Commission voted to recommend approval of the Proposed Rezoning to the City Council on the basis of general welfare and good zoning practice; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant submitted a Final Proffer Statement dated July 12, 2012, as required by City Code Section 34-64(c), and made a part of these proceedings; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that the public necessity, convenience, general welfare and good zoning practice requires the Proposed Rezoning; that both the existing zoning classifications (R-2 Residential-Two Family) and the proposed "PUD" zoning classification (subject to proffered development conditions) are reasonable; and that the Proposed Rezoning is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Charlottesville, Virginia that the Zoning District Map Incorporated in Section 34-1 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Code of the City of Charlottesville, 1990, as amended, be and hereby is amended and reenacted as follows:

Section 34-1. Zoning District Map. Rezoning from R-2 Residential-Two Family to Planned Unit Development (PUD), subject to the proffered development conditions set forth within the Final Proffer Statement, the property located off Penn Park Lane designated as Parcels 39 and 40 on City Tax Map 48A, consisting of approximately 25.6 acres, or 1,115,136 square feet.
