

Minutes of ZAB held.
Oct 21, 1976 in Conference Room 219, City

Mtg. called to order by Chairman;
Mr. Muse, read the outline used in
approving the request of United Virginia Bank
for a certificate of appropriateness to paint
this building located at 408 Park Street. the
colors as set out in the letter from Mr.
Mr. Jack Kimhart, Jr. (a copy is attached
and made part of these minutes. The
board in session ^{today} moved the formal
approval of this action.

Mr. Muse, also, informed the Board that Mr.
Robert P Makidshi had formally given his
resignation to the Mayor, because of his
leaving town, and the Mayor ^{was sent} to city
council Clerk requesting replacement for
the alternate member along with the

list of architects eligible for appointment as
replacement for Mr. Makielski.

The application of Jared L. Lake for the issuance
of a certificate of appropriateness for a sign
for his establishment located at 100 Court Square
on 6th St. N.E.

After a short discussion^{and} because the applicant
was not present it was moved by Mrs. Ramsey
that the sign be approved subject to the chairman
getting with Mr. Lake[?] to ascertain the exact
letter size and type. This was seconded by
Mrs. Wadlington. Mr. Blane then called Mr. Lake[?]
but he was not in, ^{and his secretary said she would try to} her called and ^{soon} ^{him}
talked to Mr. Lake, after which a short discussion
followed and then Mrs. Ramsey withdrew
her motion and moved that the certificate
be approved with the colors and lettering
like the sample calling card attached to
the petition.

Mr. Blane then brought up^{a building at} 305 East High St
~~a building~~ within the ADC area that shows
signs of deterioration and neglect. Photographs
were shown. And he asked the boards
concur^{ance} in that the Section 31-141 be
followed. The board unanimously concurred
and directed the Enforcing officer to
proceed.

the Board then moved that all future applications for signs include scale drawings be submitted showing size, type, and color of lettering.
