The Chairperson opened the Meeting and the Minutes of September 13, 1977 were officially approved as presented.

Case No. 77-56.

The case of Malcolm and Ruth Bell to renovate their Residence at $433\ \mathrm{North}\ \mathrm{First}\ \mathrm{Street}.$

Mr. Bell explained to the Board that they wanted to remove the stucco to expose the original clap board and paint it as near the original color as possible. He, also, asked if they could rebuild the front porch to its original design. He showed pictures that nearly matched the original.

After a short discussion it was moved by Mrs. Smith and seconded by Mrs. Ramsey that Mr. Bell be granted a Certificate of Appropriateness to proceed with the renovation with the Final Plans for the porch be submitted to the Board for approval, and unanimously carried.

Case No. 77-57.

The Petition of the Yarn Shop to install a Sign at 307 East Market Street.

Katherine C. Respess presented sketches of the proposed Sign and asked the Board for suggestions as to alternate design.

After a discussion, it was moved by Mrs. Smith that the Sign be simplified and that two colors suggested be used and a Certificate of Appropriateness be issued and if an alternate design is used it would have to be brought back to the Board for approval, seconded by Mr. Farmer and unanimously carried.
