- 1. Call to order Melanie Miller called the meeting to order at 11:08

Melanie will bring in the text for The Corner. Edwina will bring in the Town Hall/Levee Opera House. Kristin can do the McKee Block. Coordinate with the Dialogue on Race committee on the Vinegar Hill neighborhood marker – Genevieve will be able to contact Charlene Green who is on the committee.

Bus Posters – Melanie explained that the Lee Park Bus Poster will be ready once the paper to print it on gets in. She suggested working on the Swan Tavern Bus Poster next. She is still looking for the image for the poster. There is a flier service that Melanie mentioned which could post the posters for the committee, however, the service mostly covers UVA bulletin
