2016: This three-bay, one-story, frame and stucco house was built around 1927. The first major rehabilitation took place in 1957 when a one-bay rear porch was enclosed (City Tax Records). The current dwelling has a gabled, standing seam metal roof with a central interior brick chimney. The 2/2 wood windows appear original although the door on the central entrance may be a replacement. A three-bay, integral porch with shed roof, overhanging eaves and exposed rafters covers the entire facade. The porch has a modern parged concrete foundation, turned posts, and wood rails. A two-bay cross gable wing is joined to the rear of the structure. According to Sanborn maps, this addition may have been an early amendment to the house, appearing only a few years after construction.
