# PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES April 20, 2016

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board held a regular meeting on Wednesday March 16, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. held @ Carver Recreation Center. Members present were: Ruth Barnett, Elise Cruz, Jody Lahendro, Ned Michie, and Maurice Walker. Member absent: Llezelle Dugger, Anne Hemenway, David Hirschman and Scott Morgan

Staff: Brian Daly, Doug Ehman, Vic Garber, Mindy Dodge Skatepark Committee – Dan Zimmerman, Desiree Dawson, Dwayne Brown *Minutes* 

- Ned Michie asked for a correction to the minutes, remove his name from last sentence the Skatepark Committee to come to a meeting and replace with Maurice Walker
- Ruth Barnett made a motion to approve corrected March 16, 2016 minutes, Elise Cruz second, motion was unanimously approved.

#### Facility Operations Update

- Vic Garber introduced Mindy Dodge as the new Program Manager for Youth Program, she will be supervising registered classes, fitness, camps and special events
- ➤ Vic Garber stated that Riaan Anthony, Facilities Manager, was in charge of dry land operations, 4 recreation centers Key, Carver, Tonsler, Crow; Washington Park, housing sites and Skatepark
  - Housing sites provides after school meals @ these sites, average 8,500 participants
     yearly, 15-25 participants/evening
  - Key Midnight basketball program on Friday nights; 3 staff plus a police officer, 27,000 users
  - o Key pickle ball, basketball, volleyball,
  - o Crow Martial Arts, crafts, boxing, therapeutic camp
  - Tonsler 12,000 visits, new playground, basketball courts, track, expect to become much busier
- Youth/Adult programs
- ➤ Carver fitness room, arts & crafts, (8) birthday parties average, will be closed end of August refurbish multi-purpose floor
- McIntire Skatepark facility is supervised, new facility will not be supervised, participants sign in/out, 45 percent non residents
- New security cameras are being installed @ Key @ Tonsler;
- Maurice Walker asked about Shakespeare in the Park, Vic Garber replied that the department did have the event two years ago, but last year they couldn't do, not planning it this year

#### Skate Park Committee

- Committee presented at a board meeting 4 years ago
- > History:
  - 1995 origin of the Skatepark City Council approved a temporary location @ tennis courts
     McIntire Park
  - o 1998 ramp donated by skater

- o 1999 multi use
- o 2004 wooden bowl donated
- o 2008 new modular skate ramps city/county
- o 2010 started process where facility would be moved to
- o 2012 approved & included in McIntire East project
- Temporary location is 1/3 size as before; has beginner & intermediate equipment now; no high skilled
- o Averages 2,000 10,000 users
- New Skatepark facility will have people coming from all over the country when it is built
- Ned Michie asked if county could chip in for funding; Brian Daly replied that Albemarle
   County has given \$140,000 for relocation & design
- Scott Morgan asked about sponsorship; Vic Garber replied that they have received a \$25,000 Tony Hawks grant; waiting to hear about two other sponsorships
- Brian Daly stated that construction won't start until funding is in place, probably mid-late fall; construction will take 8-9 months,

#### Meadowcreek Valley Master Plan Implementation

- Doug Ehman stated that the Flood Plain Study for Meadowcreek Valley was received three weeks ago, staff has reviewed, no issues
- City funding \$325,000, grant; \$130-140,000 cost for bridges

#### Tonsler Park Master Plan implementation Update

- ➤ Brian Daly stated that there have been two planning meetings on the spray park design, not well attended, but did get guidance; Not sure if will need to hold 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting
- Looking @ plaza type features; architect team working on the conceptual design; will include one/two unit restroom to that side of the park, restroom inside the facility,

#### Update of Piedmont Family YMCA

- Doug Ehman stated that the project was moving along
- Ruth Barnett about the Dogwood Festival held in McIntire Park with construction going on; Brian Daly replied that there were no complaints

## Ragged Mountain Planning Process Update & Schedule

- ➤ Brian Daly stated that there had been two public meetings; first meeting was informational, second was open night. Next meeting will be next Wednesday, 6 pm @ Trinity Church on Fontaine Avenue, will talk about uses, where do rest of trails go, etc.
- Press release later this week
- > City Council will make final decision; will come to Advisory Board first.

#### Adopted FY 17 Budget & Capital Improvement Program

➤ Budget was adopted by City Council last week. Operating hours @ facilities will not change; was \$9,700 reduction in Parks from summer annuals

CIP – reduced \$450,000; \$200,000 - Skatepark, \$250,000 – Meadowcreek Valley or McIntire projects

- Maurice Walker stated that he appreciated the two dog areas @ Azalea Park
- Asked if department was involved in controversy in Lee Park; Brian Daly replied that it was a community decision

Brian Daly reported that this Friday @ 10:45 am there would be a 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary ceremony for the Dogwood Vietnam Memorial
